Please note that the Hilton Concord Hotel (925-827-2000) is located at the center of San Francisco's East Bay, 30 miles from Oakland Airport, and 40 miles from San Francisco Airport. Take a Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) bus to the BART Station. From Oakland BART the cost is (\$4.00), from SF (\$10.25), to Concord Station.

Traveling by car: Exit on Willow Pass Road off the I-680. Turn right on Willow Pass (Left if southbound on I-680), Turn left on Diamond.
